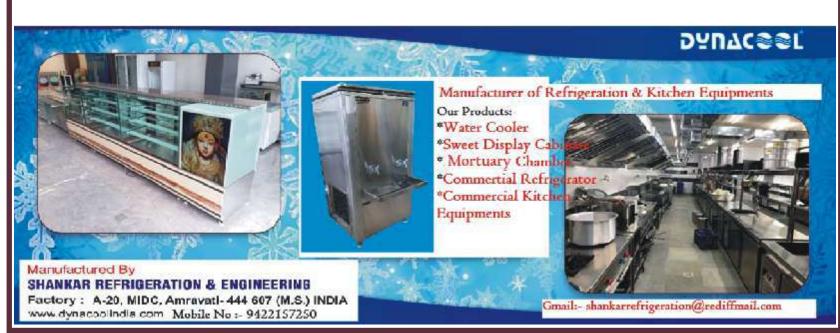

Memories down the lane

At the outset I extend my thanks to Dr. Ravindra Kasat for entrusting on me the task of writing down my memories of the Club. I have naratted what I recollect permitted by my age, being the senior most member along with Mr. G.A. Patkar (as per joinig date of Club membership).

One day some time in 1970 I along with Late Dr. Balkrishna and Late Dr. S.K. Bose were sitting at the home of Dr. Bose, when Late Mr. Murliseth Rathi, Late Mr. Kishor Narsoo, Late Mr. Harish Malani and Mr. G. A. Patkar visited us at about 11.00 am. They put before us the idea of taking over the Reforms Club and renovating it. The Club was lying defunct till then with an old building with three big rooms and one billiard room with a British time billiard table. Somehow I don't know why one room was blocked with some MSEB



goods inside. I heard then that 4-5 old members were the custodian of the Club and they did not encourage new membership. I heard that the last surviving member would be the sole owner of the Club as per the prevailing constitution. But Murliseth Rathi investigated, argued and we 8-10 members joined the membership. Somehow Murliseth Rathi took over the management. First thing was of course to increase the number of members which gradually increased with the sole consent of Murliseth Rathi. He being the poineer, was respected by members and his decision was always taken as final. Then the next agenda was to re-write the constitution which I think senior member Late Pavnaskar, Late Justice R.S. Padhey and some others did it. It was approved by the executive committee and submitted to the office of Charity Commissioner.

The Club had a beauthfull surrounding. We 10-15 members would gather there in the evening and enjoy a good gathering. Drinks were brought from outside and consumed there. The remaining stuff was kept under the custody of Late Mr. Shivanna who was a billiard marker of British Time. He was always in British style with coat put on. The table and room was under his supervision. He taught the game of billiards to all of us. For many years the care takers of the Club were these Andhrite Annas like Shivanna, Pittana, Hirrana etc. and their families residing in the campus. They were all interrelated. The routine continued for years i.e. drinks, snacks and food. The food department was managed by Pittana another British time cook who served both English and Indian dashes. The taste of the preparations by him still lingers over my tongue. Shivanna was later on asked to open his bar and we use to purchase drinks from him only. There was, again, a British time peg measure which is served with I think that the peg measure was there in the Club upto 90's.

The strength of the members went on increasing year by year. The tennis court was also renovated and made playable so that some of our members and members from Officer's Club use to play on that court. Members also started using one room and named it as card room. Few interested members started playing rummy. I still remember the management enforced the rule that the rummy stake should not be more than 25 paisa. Sole interest of the management was that the game should be for entertainment only and not gambling.

The strength gradually increased and development of the Club was the priority. Murliseth Rathi and others decided to sale some of the land of the Club. This raised the funds for overall development. Some of us became life members paying one time fees of Rs. 1,500/- only. The tennis court, card room, kitchen, billiard room etc. were renovated. I think, by this time our famous cook whom we called Pant joined the kitchen services. He serves many varieties of delicious dishes. Every member was pleased and even guests entertained in the Club appreciate the food and thus our Club became famous for its food.

Meanwhile in 1980 the permit room was opened and the bar was setup. I will give full credit to Murliseth Rathi for this effort. By this time some incidents of quarrels happened and Club was divided in groups which ultimately landed in Club elections. In 1981-82. I was Secretary and Late Lalbhai Mehta was the President along with Late Madanlal Verma as Treasurer. We decided to build a big hall where family get-togethers can be arranged. As the funds were meager we constructed a hall having a roof of galvanized tins. We use to organize film show every fortnight and families of members attended it. The films were projected by 8 mm projector. The greatest drawback was the eco problem and the children of families of police line nearby the Club. Thus this effort was a failure and abandoned shortly.

Day by day the groupism increased and again there were elections in 1982-83. Late Dr. Balkrishna and Late Dr. A.P. Deshmukh contested in which Dr. A.P. Deshmukh got elected. Both were doctors and both were friends! This atmosphere of bitterness went on and thereby the congenial atmosphere was lost. This was the time when Dr. Vijay Agrawal emerged as leader. At the time of elections there were two panels, one of Murliseth Rathi and other of Dr. Vijay Agrawal, against each other. But most of the time as both being very practical elections were avoided by compromise. As the time passed Murliseth Rathi lost his health to a great extent and ultimately left for heavenly abode.

Dr. Vijay Agrawal was very keen social worker. He developed a very good association with the members and put up new plans for the progress and development of the Club, not in a dictatorship manner but with a pleasant convincing way. He became key figure in running of the Club and I hope his is still a very key person. Lots of developments which we saw like swimming pool, new hall, new kitchen etc. could be brought. I think I should stop here because they say "Past memory is better than present memory." I know the present members know all well more than me, about how the Club progressed in last 10-15 years.

Many of us called it as our second home. I don't know how much that is correct. But definitely it can be made into homely atmosphere so that the members, though sometimes land in election but that is obvious in democracy. Let us all join together and see that the progress will create a reputation of this Club as one of the best in at least Maharashtra Region.
